A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the month of July 2017 as "Lake Awareness Month" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's landscape is home to more than 1,500
4 lakes, ponds and reservoirs, which are critical resources to
5 Pennsylvania's environment and quality of life; and

6 WHEREAS, Lakes are one of Pennsylvania's most valuable
7 natural resources, supplying water for municipal, industrial and
8 agricultural use, assisting with flood control and providing
9 scenic beauty and a habitat for wildlife; and

10 WHEREAS, Lakes offer a variety of recreational opportunities,
11 including boating, swimming and fishing; and

12 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Lake Management Society is a great
13 resource for ways each resident can contribute in a positive way
14 to the health of this Commonwealth's waters; and

15 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth recognizes the need to protect
16 lakes and ponds for future generations; therefore be it
